Mr. Pharmacist	2:35	The Other Half	A psychedelic hard rock band, based in San Francisco. Covered by the Fall in 1986
Transfusion	2:26	Nervous Norvus	Jimmy Drake. A major hit in 1956. The same car crash sound effect appears on on Dead Man's Curve by Jan and Dean and Leader of the Pack.
Shoppin' For Clothes	3:01	The Coasters	1960. The first song Leiber and Stoller made for The Coasters after their falling out with Elvis' manager.

Over Night Sensation	5:24	Raspberries	From Cleveland, Ohio, includes Eric Carmen on vocals and guitar. 1974.
Feeling Good	2:53	Nina Simone	Written by English singer-songwriters Anthony Newley and Leslie Bricusse for the 1964 musical The Roar of the Greasepaint – The Smell of the Crowd
Ace Insurance Man	3:34	Bobbie Gentry	1968, from her 3rd album Local Gentry
Happy Boy	1:21	Beat Farmers	A cowpunk band which formed in San Diego, California in 1983 by Country Dick Montana, he died of a heart attack in 1995. From their first album Tales of the New West, produced by Blasters / Los Lobos saxophonist Steve Berlin
Common Man	3:43	The Blasters	Formed by brothers Phil Alvin (vocals and guitar) and Dave Alvin (guitar) in 1979. Featured on Hard Line, 1985, their final studio album
If I Had A Boat	3:09	Lyle Lovett	From second studio album, released in 1987.
Love Hangover	4:24	The Associates	Recorded by Diana Ross in 1975, this from 1982 - double A side with 18 Carat Love Affair
Empire State Human	3:18	Human League	From the band's 1979 debut album Reproduction.
Rock Me Gently	3:27	Andy Kim	1974. Canadian singer, co-wrote and sang on The Archies Sugar Sugar.
Shake And Vibrate	2:27	Sir Lattimore Brown	1966, the flip of It's Such A Sad, Sad World.
I Spy (For The FBI)	2:35	Jamo Thomas	An American Northern soul, soul and funk singer, best remembered for this 1966 hit single. Covered by The Untouchables in 1985.
